1. STAND E PERSONALIZZAZIONI

1.1. BOOKINGS

- To reserve a booth in the Expo Area please send the "Stand Application 2019" to office@420hempfest.com.
- To request a sponsorship package please send and email to Per richieste/offerte di sponsorizzazione office@420hempfest.com.
- For partnership and special projects please send and email to info@420hempfest.com.

The Organizer will confirm the booth availability. The booking is valid at the time of the firm on the Lease and Sponsorship Agreement and the prepayment of space. The final payment must be done no later than **April, 5th 2019**.

The Exhibitor will send the contract signed, the Business Terms and Conditions signed and the form "Exhibitor Personal Data 2019" duly filled and signed in all its parts.

In case of incomplete payment and documentation after this date, the space is considered available for sale and the exhibitor will not be allowed to access the area. The Organizer has the right to change position or stand measures at his own discretion in the event of technical and organizational needs.

1.2. BOOTH OPTIONS

- In the AREA INDICA, as for the "Floorplan 2019" sent by email or on the website, it is possible to request a Floor Only booth, a Box Truss booth or a Modular Booth. The sector of the Area Indica are the following: Grow/Seeds/Head only manufacturers, distributors and registered brands.
- In the AREA SATIVA and AREA RUDERALIS it is possible to request modular booth only. The following stands can be floor only: R20, R9, S20, S9. The sector of the Area Sativa and Area Ruderalis are the following: CBD, Grow Shop, Hemp Shop, Head Shop.
- In the AREA KUSH and AREA HAZE it is possible to request modular booth only. The sector of the Area Kush and Area Haze are the following: CBD, Industrial Hemp, Cosmetics, Textiles, associations.

The Floor Only Booth includes green carpet and electrical supply (max 6kw). The box truss stand is a steel support structure with green moquette and electrical supply (max 6kw). The modular stand is a "Show Room" system made of natural aluminum and laminated panels. It includes green carpet, sign with the Exhibitor's name, electrical supply according to the following table:

1.3. COSTS

All the costs of the Expo Area booth can be requested by email or can be downloaded from the website. To download the module please ask the password to office@420hempfest.com.

1.4. STAND LAYOUT

In case of modular stand, Exhibitors must send the drawing containing the details required for the setting up and staging of his stand **by April, the 5th 2019**. The Exhibitor must specify on the form the orientation of the stand, the walls, the position of the track with spotlights, of the electrical socket and of furnishings. In case of failure or delay in reception of the form, or approximate compilations, the organization will stage independently and it will not be able for the Exhibitor to ask subsequent changes thereto.

1.5. FURNITURE AND EXTRA SERVICES

In case of modular stand, it will be possible to ask for furniture and services through the Furniture and Services Catalogue, filling and sending the Furniture and Services Application Form no later than **April, 5th 2019** to the dedicated email.

It is possible to ask for extra services such as printing and application of wall graphics in FOREX®. Requests for customization of the walls must be received **within April 5th, 2019** by sending graphics to the dedicated email address. The graphics must be scaled 1:1, with a 150/300 dpi resolution and accompanied with a description of their position. The furnishings, as well as walls and other supplies, must be returned at the end of the fair in the same initial state. It is not allowed to apply adhesives on furnishings or walls or make other changes. Costs arising from damages will be charged to the Exhibitor.

The electrical supply is 3kW for each Modular stand and will be used exclusively for the lighting and setting up stands. To request a higher power supply, please write to info@420hempfest.com. The Organizer is expressly exempted from any liability for any damage that the exhibitor would suffer due to the failure to activate the requested service, as well as for the suspension or termination of the same for causes not attributable to the Organizer.

Outside the area of every Exhibitor's own space advertising is allowed only by means of these services. Any kind of advertisement outside the stand not agreed with the Organizer is strictly forbidden. The organization has the right to remove unauthorized material, and to stop all other unauthorized advertising activities.

3. BOOTH SET UP

3.1. SETTING UP AND DISMANTLING

It will be allowed to assemble the stand only after the contract signature, the full payment of space and extra services and the submitting of the required forms. If the full payment of the stand and extra services is not carried out before the 1st of May the exhibitor will not be allowed to access the festival to set up the stand. Each Exhibitor must deal with the stand setting up on his own. The Exhibitor is obliged to set up the stand in the space assigned: all structures and sign of the stand must not occupy spaces outside the stand perimeter. Stand setting up and dismantling must take place strictly during the times indicated above. Assembly, disassembly and organization are not allowed during the event. You cannot remove entirely or partially the stand before the end of the event. At the end of the event and not before, Exhibitors will remove products and materials installed. In case of non-compliance in clearing the area with the time of dismantling and / or inaction by the Exhibitor, any goods, materials, tools found in the area after the deadline stated in this document will be considered as waste. Stand setting up and dismantling must be in compliance with the regulations. It is forbidden to make, during setting up and dismantling, temporary installations which do not comply with current regulations. It is compulsory to use fire retardants and self-extinguishing materials. Exhibitor is obliged to use electrical equipment complying with local CE-marked regulations. It is strictly forbidden to make any modifications to the electrical system provided. Any change must be authorized by the organization. The Organiser reserves the right to remove or edit at the

expense and risk of the offending hand, equipment considered as dangerous and/or not suitable for the event, and/or not complying with regulations. The Organiser has the right to remove, at the Exhibitor's expense, any dangerous object having not been previously agreed without entailing a right to compensation or any form of compensation in favour of the Exhibitor. Failure of these rules entitle the Organiser to take precautionary measures against the Exhibitor acting irregularly in terms of fire prevention and security. Non-observance of safety rules may be reported to the Judicial Authority. In order to respect of safety legislation, the Organizer may define special regulations concerning access to the exhibition area during the setting up and dismantling phase, for people, goods and vehicles. The Exhibitor is responsible for returning the assigned space to the organization in the same condition as it was in before the setting up. It is forbidden to alter the host structure and the materials provided by the organization in any way. The Organizer reserves the right to implement all necessary measures to avoid further damage. The organization cannot be held responsible for any damage caused to the structures or alterations thereof. Any costs arising from damage or deterioration of the structures will be entirely charged to the offender. The organization is not responsible for any accidents and damage or loss of items or equipment left unattended during the setting up and dismantling. In case of damage of the exhibitor's graphic materials during the dismantling from the Organizer staff, there will not be refunds but the graphic materials will be produced or procured at the expenses of the Organizer. Exhibitors do not have direct access to warehouses for the pallet-storage. The staff of the organization will remove them from the stand before the opening time for visitors and to bring them back to the stand during the dismantling phase. Exhibitors cannot use the pallet truck, platforms or other machinery and equipment in the structure. They must always refer to the staff of the organisation. It is possible to require portorage service by sending the Furniture and Services Application Form **by April, the 5th 2019**.

The exhibitors that will not respect the schedule above will be charged of €200 for each additional hour.

3.2. ACCESS TO THE EXPO AREA

Only personnel with passes can enter in the exhibition space during the setting up and the dismantling.

The staff working inside the stand for the three days of the fair will be provided with pass that will guarantee access to the location during the fair set-up, development and dismantling phases. The Organizer staff is allowed to request the identity document of the exhibitor's staff at the entrance.

It is mandatory for each stand to communicate the internal staff that will provide service during the days of the fair (set up / dismantling). Passes must be requested in advance by sending the appropriate form to the dedicated email address no later than April 5, 2019 and must be picked up at the Info Point upon arrival. No more passes will be given to the Exhibitor than the number indicated in the "Pass Request 2019".

It is mandatory for companies to hire staff within the terms of law, in particular with respect to contractual conditions, workplace safety and insurance status. Exhibitor, aware of the liability and criminal penalties provided for by law, false statements and false declarations, having regard to the provisions of Italian and European law, with reference to the work of fitting out and dismantling the exhibition space, declares to be in rules with the payment of contributions to its employees, has assessed the risks to the safety and health of its employees in accordance with the law and has prepared the relevant risk assessment document. It also declares that the workers involved in the assembly and disassembly work have been informed and trained in accordance with the law in relation to the risks of their duties, which have been judged appropriate by the medical officer responsible for carrying out those duties, which are in possession of the necessary individual safety devices that the company has the organization, the means and work equipment needed to carry out the activities and that they all comply with the provisions in force on the prevention of accidents at work and are verified and maintained in accordance with the prescriptions in the user manuals and maintenance manuals.

3.3. SETTING UP / DISMANTLING THE FLOOR ONLY BOOTH

For stands booked as bare area and set up by the Exhibitor, the measures of the structure have to meet exactly those previously agreed. The maximum height of the stand must be 4 meters, unless differently agreed with the Organizer.

Exhibitors are obliged to present to the organizer, in advance, the project to set up the assigned space, including lighting, audio and video installations.

In this connection it is recalled that additional electrical installations can only be carried out by companies in possession of the requisites prescribed by Law 37/2008. Therefore, the Exhibitor is required to send, by and no later than **April 5th 2019**, a copy of the documentation relating to the aforementioned requirements of the chosen electric company.

In the event that the expected power commitment exceeds 6 kW, the Exhibitor must send a copy of the related project signed by a qualified professional by that date. Before the beginning the certificate of conformity (Law 37/2008) signed by a qualified professional must be issued.

At the end of the operations and before the start of the event, the Exhibitor must issue an appropriate declaration of correct assembly signed by a qualified professional.

For the preparation of the spaces, only materials approved in accordance with the D. M. 26/6/84 and its modifications and additions according to the fire reaction classes and on the basis of the tests carried out by the Center for Studies and Experiments of the Ministry of the Interior.

Walls and curtains must be made of material in the class not exceeding "1".

Floors must be in class not more than "2".

The materials used to make ceilings or ceilings must be approved in class "1" tested ceiling or tested as drapery without dripping. Materials that must be treated with fireproofing products must undergo treatment before their introduction into spaces.

The fireproofing treatment must be accompanied by a regular declaration, showing:

- a) The list of materials submitted for treatment;
- b) The date of the fireproofing occurrence;
- c) The main technical characteristics of the product used;
- d) The personal data of the performer who must certify the regular execution of the treatment.

All the materials must be accompanied by the certificates of proof attesting the homologation, as well as by supporting documentation that certifies their provenance. The use of non-homologated plastic materials, non-fireproof synthetic fiber fabrics, paints and nitrocellulose and oil paints, paper upholstery and all materials not accompanied by a regular approval certificate as described above is forbidden.

All certificates must be delivered to the Organizer before the event begins.

In order to avoid the accumulation of toxic gases in the spaces, it is forbidden for anyone to access inside them with vehicles or machines with internal combustion engine. The Dealer will be able to introduce equipment and goods in the spaces exclusively by hand or with pushed or electric equipment.

By way of derogation from the foregoing, the stationing of internal combustion engine vehicles is permitted for commercial purposes only, provided that the vehicle's electric power battery is disconnected and that the tank is fuel-free. No exemption for vehicles powered by gas is permitted.

The points of support for the restaurant service are usually located outside on areas immediately adjacent to the spaces. Any provisional structures (tensile structures, pagodas, etc.) must be installed in such a way that the emergency exits and escape routes provided for by the fire regulations are not obstructed. At the end of the assembly of the structures, the calculation reports and the certificate of correct assembly signed by a qualified professional must be issued. For the preparation of food is allowed only the use of electrical equipment; therefore it is expressly forbidden to use gas cookers both inside and outside the spaces.

At the end of the service, the area must be returned free of any organic waste and special waste. If this does not happen, the organizer will intervene directly, recharging the relative cleaning and disposal costs to the Exhibitor. The Exhibitor will have to answer for any damage caused by the drainage in external manhole covers. structures, such as drainage obstruction, introduction of foul-smelling liquid and solid waste.

The stand will have to be set up inside the space delimited by the carpet, or, alternatively, from the adhesive tape on the floor. All materials used by Exhibitors for setting up their stands must be fire-resistant and comply with current regulations. All the documents certifying the viability of the structures and the suitability of the materials required for the issuance of the authorization from the control bodies, must be sent by the Exhibitor to the Organizer no later than the deadline of **April 5th, 2019**. In case of failure to provide such documentation or if this it is considered not appropriate by the competent authorities, the Exhibitor will not be able to install his own structures.

In the construction of the stands it is mandatory to:

- create complete sets that are also decorative on the walls bordering other stands;
- strictly comply with the accident prevention regulations provided for by Italian law and in particular the provisions of Legislative Decree 81/2008 and subsequent amendments and additions;
- to leave visible and accessible both the hydrants and any form of fire protection, the points of supply of

- electricity, compressed air, telephone junction boxes and any other technical service;
- leave the lifts and elevators, gates and driveways accessible;
 - ensure the full availability of the emergency exits, transit areas and escape routes, avoiding any encumbrance or protrusion that may prevent access, even temporarily, to the same;
 - in areas / stands, with closed rooms, with a surface of more than 100 square meters, to provide at least a 120 cm security exit, to a safe place, beyond the entrances, and to indicate in the various rooms and / or settings the exit from the area; these indications must operate autonomously and be visible in the event that the general lighting system of the pavilion is turned off;
 - stands with a blind counter-ceiling must be equipped with an autonomous emergency lighting system sufficient for the exhibition activity.

The Organizer cannot be considered legally responsible of any breach of the rules by the Exhibitor. Any responsibility concerning setting up and the activity implementation is in charge to the Exhibitor, who expressly exonerate the Organizer for any damage caused to himself and / or to third parties by the setting up or due to wrong calculations or imperfect construction.

4. CLEANING

The Organizer will take care at his own expense of the general cleaning of the exhibition hall and passages between the stands. It remains in charge of the Exhibitor cleaning his own exhibition space before, during, and after the event.

At the end of the service, the area must be returned free of any organic waste and special waste. If this does not happen, the organizer will intervene directly, recharging the relative cleaning and disposal costs to the Exhibitor. The Exhibitor shall be liable for any damages caused by the drainage in manhole covers outside the East End Studios facilities, such as unloading, discharge of liquid and stinking liquids.

5. SHIPPING AND RETURN PRODUCTS

Pallets of good can be delivered at East End Studios from on the 1st May, from 08:00 to 18:00. Please consider that the 1st of May is a public holiday, please verify it with your shipping company. The Exhibitor has to communicate if the goods will arrive with a poised or standard truck.

The number to call for delivery is +393405675494.

On the goods delivered in the fair location must be clearly specified the Exhibitor's name and stand number. In case of pallets/boxes/packages delivered before the 1st of May, and / or outside timetable indicated in this paragraph and / or without precise indications on Exhibitor and booth number, the organization cannot be held responsible for any loss, theft or damage.

After the fair the removal of the goods shall take place on Monday 6th from 9:00 a.m. to 17:00 p.m.

Pallets/Boxes/Packages which must be collected by the courier must indicate clearly the Exhibitor's name, the total number of pallets to be collected, the name of the company in charge of the withdrawal, the final destination. After 17:00 p.m. of Monday 6th May and in the case of parcels without clear information, the organization cannot be held responsible for any loss, damage or theft.

During the event it will be possible to stock the empty pallets in the common warehouses. Exhibitors are not allowed to access to the common warehouse during the event.

6. ACCESS TO THE EXPO

6.1. EXHIBITORS PASS

Three-day passes during the fair will be provided to the working personnel of the stand, in order to grant access during the setting-up and dismantling phase, and during the event. It is mandatory for each booth to communicate internal staff of the stand that will work during the exhibition days (setting up / dismantling). The passes must be previously requested by sending the form "Passes request" to the dedicated email address no later than April 5st, 2019. Passes must be asked for to the fair Organizers upon arrival.

6.2. PASS REQUEST

It is possible to ask for the "Pass request 2019" form writing an email to office@420hempfest.com. There will not release more passes than the number indicated in the form. The exhibitor can buy tickets with reduced cost. More info inside the "Pass request 2019".

6.3. PROFESSIONAL ACCREDITATION

The Exhibitor can suggest to his customers and industry professionals to apply for accreditation by means of the link on our website. The accreditation has a three-day validity. The deadline to apply for accreditation is April 14st, 2019.

6.4. ACCESS OF VEHICLES

Access of vehicles is allowed in the forecourt and on the back just for loading and unloading goods and exclusively outside opening hours to the public of the exhibition space, only with a specific permit which has to be requested before 14st of April 2019.

One car pass will be provided for each stand.

During the event and in any case outside opening hours to the public, any loading and unloading operations can be requested at the staff in the Welcome Area/ Info Point.

It is also forbidden to stop temporarily at the safety exits.

7. OTHER OBLIGATIONS AND BANS

The Exhibitor can carry on his activities exclusively in the allocated space.

7.1. FOOD AND DRINKS

The commercial exhibitor can sell only packaged products not intended for consumption on site.

The administration of food and drinks by the commercial exhibitor is not permitted, unless specific agreements and explicit provisions are made by the organizer. Only the Food exhibitor can supply food and drinks in dedicated areas. The Commercial Exhibitor's that will sell food and drinks for consumption will be sanctioned with a fine. The amount of the fine is the difference between the Food Stand and the Commercial stand based on the mq stand.

7.2. FISCAL POSITION AND COOPERATION

It is compulsory for Exhibitor to take full responsibility both of the working performance and the social security and tax status and position of his personnel. Exhibitor is responsible for his own activities, in terms of administrative, civil and penal law, exempting the Organizer from possible consequences arising from activities carried out within the stand assigned.

7.3. SELLING RESTRICTION

The Organizer may require the exclusion of some products such as counterfeit goods, burned CDs or other merchandise which is not in compliance with the laws in force and that has not been specified in this contract. It is absolutely forbidden to display / sell products containing toxic substances, as well as all smart drugs or substances with a THC concentration exceeding the limits set by Italian and European laws.

7.4. DAMAGE TO GOODS OR PERSON

The organizer is not responsible for any damage caused to things or people caused by exhibitors and their staff, as well as by facilities set up and / or assembled by them, by visitors who will attend the event.

The organizer is not liable for damages caused to things or people caused by installations and facilities made available by the East end Studios and / or its staff.

For any damage caused by the exhibitor and / or his personnel and / or the preparation of his stand and / or the goods displayed, the exhibitor is solely liable. The exhibitor is responsible for the storage of his stand for the entire period of the fair including the days of assembly and disassembly. Therefore the Exhibitor is obliged to provide for the stipulation of suitable insurance coverage.

The exhibitor is obliged to ensure:

- a) the stand and products exhibited or otherwise existing on the stand against all risks (purely by way of non-limiting example: theft, fire, malicious events in general, damage from infiltrations or falling water, natural events in general, breakages , ruins) with the exception of the possibility of recourse against the Organizer;
- b) the civil liability of the exhibitor for damages caused to third parties and their employees, as well as damages caused to the Organizer and its employees and / or employees.

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for damage caused to persons or property, by anyone and however caused; consequently no damages deriving will be refunded, purely by way of non limiting example, from thefts, fires, explosions, malicious events in general, natural events in general, water infiltrations, breakages, ruins and any damage to third parties deriving from liability the exhibitor, his employees or fitters appointed by him, both inside and near the fairgrounds. The aforementioned conditions also apply to the granting of the extension of the fitting of the stands.

The exhibitor is obliged to inform the Organizer of the details of the aforementioned insurance coverage, if requested.

7.5. FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

The Exhibitor is obliged to set up exclusively his own space and use only flame-retardant and selfextinguishing materials. The Exhibitor must not obstruct crossings, emergency exits, ramps, corridors and escape routes. Smoking it is strictly forbidden in all indoor areas of the fairgrounds. Lighting fires, flames, producing high temperatures, use gas cylinders methane and / or LPG, accumulating waste or combustible waste is strictly forbidden. It is forbidden to smoke inside the Space used by the Concessionaire in accordance with Article 1 L. No. 584 11/11/1975, Law No. 448 of 11/28/2001, Law 311 of 12/30/2004. Transgressors will be punished a rule of law.

7.6. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Displayed products and goods, as well as the stands housing them, may not be photographed, filmed or otherwise reproduced without the authorization of both Exhibitors and Organizer. Distributing and reproducing general views as well as interior and external details are at the sole Organizer discretion.

7.7. MUSIC, SMELLS, LIGHTS, EXHIBITIONS

Sounds emissions, lights and smells provoking, at the sole judgment of the Organizer, nuisance to visitors or other Exhibitors, are forbidden.

The Exhibitor is not allowed to play music inside the stand.

The organization will provide background music.

The presentation of videos and slides is allowed, but all sounds must be adjusted in such a way as not to disturb visitors and neighboring exhibitors.

It is strictly forbidden to project images that may violate the rights of image and advertising, or the right to personal and family privacy, of the organization and of the East End Studios.

All the audio / video material reproduced is part of the Italian legislation that protects copyright. Exhibitors wishing to reproduce copyrighted audio / video material will have to comply with the obligations established by the SIAE, owner of copyright protection in Italy.

7.8. OTHER PROHIBITIONS

It is obligatory for those who access the Exhibition Center to maintain a civil behavior, in respect of the goods and equipment owned by the Exhibition Center and by present and non-involved third parties, and to comply with the

provisions and instructions given by the Organizer at the entrance and inside the District with appropriate signs, with written notices, with amplifonic communiques, as well as through the service staff and by any other means, with the clarification that the amplifonic communiques and the instructions given by the service staff prevail on other notices. It is forbidden for anyone to promote, within the Fairgrounds, offers, quests and oblations for institutions of any kind, to carry out religious, political or trade union activities, and any activity not relevant to the purposes of the current Event, unless expressly written authorization of the Organizer. During the events access to the District to minors of 18 years will be allowed only if accompanied by adult family members. It is forbidden to bring animals of any kind into the Exhibition Center, except for dogs serving blind people. Exhibitors, their exhibitors and agents are also expressly forbidden to leave cars or vehicles inside the Exhibition Center at times other than those granted by the organizer and during the entire period of the event, unless otherwise provided by the Manager. The Organizer has the right to integrate and cancel the previous provisions, and to derogate from them, giving notice of them in the ways deemed most suitable to guarantee full knowledge of them. Failure to comply with the obligations established in this regulation may result in withdrawal of entry documents and immediate removal from the District of the persons responsible for the violation, as well as in the case of exhibitors or their collaborators, the temporary or permanent closure of the stand, without any economic prejudice against the Organizer and without prejudice to any damage suffered by the Organizer.

It is also forbidden:

- Smoking inside the pavilions and closed areas inside the fair district - law 16 January 2003 n. 3, art. 51 (Protection of non-smoking health);
- It is absolutely forbidden to expose / sell products that contain any of the toxic substances - according to Regulation (EC) no. 1907/2006 - and illegal - listed in Presidential Decree 309/90 and related updates - as well as all smart drugs or any substance containing THC with a concentration higher than the limits imposed by Italian and European laws. In the event that such substances are exposed, the Organization will have the right to take the appropriate measures or request the intervention of the Police. If the following eventualities occur, the Organizer is not responsible for: - pierce, infix nails and / or screws into the walls, ceilings, floors, columns and any other internal and external surface of the pavilions;
- apply loads to the structures of the pavilions, to the walls, to the piling for lighting, to the blinds, even if they are light posters, cables, panels, banners;
- painting, either by hand or by spraying, the stand structures inside the halls, whether they are varnishes and / or enamels, whether they are washable water-based paints and also subject the material itself to fire-retardant treatment inside the pavilions;
- carry out welding work of any type and nature and in any case the use of open flames;
- spread the pavilions on the floor: flammable and / or combustible products, chemical products, solvents that can cause the floor to break up or alter;
- smearing the floors, walls, equipment owned by the Organizer with paint, glue, adhesives and double-sided adhesive or other, as well as affixing adhesives to them;
- drag heavy loads, hit the floor with blunt instruments, circulate in the pavilions with vehicles without wheeled tires and that can still ruin the floor;
- carry out excavations or changes to the layout of the exhibition areas;
- introduce explosive, detonating, asphyxiating, flammable and otherwise hazardous materials into the exhibition premises without the necessary authorizations from the competent authorities and prior authorization from the Organizer;
- operate machinery exhibited, unless previously authorized by the Organizer;
- deposit any type of installation material inside the exhibition center, with the exception of the areas leased by the Organizer and the adjoining ones in the event that this does not constitute an obstacle to the passage and in any case for the time strictly necessary for the use of such material;
- use the Organizer's mark;
- provoke harassment or disturbance, in any form, to the regular conduct of the events, under penalty of immediate exclusion from the Exhibition Center;
- carry out political and union propaganda in the district;
- introduce and use G.P.L. and methane;
- discharging waste water into the secondary tunnels of the pavilions without the aid of special drainage pipes to be inserted in correspondence with the drains;
- dispose of corrosive waters for metals and cement, solidifying substances, foul-smelling water, colors;
- to carry out direct connections to the services (water, electricity, telephone, etc.) on their own or through third

parties not authorized by the Organizer - abandon machinery and vehicles with fuel in the tanks;
- abandon the stands in the pavilions, such as carpets or residues of any kind.
- to stretch or lay supports for the provision of technical services on the floor or at altitude along the crossing routes.

7.9. SURVEILLANCE

The Organizer provides surveillance during day and night. Nevertheless, he cannot be held responsible for theft or damage to the stand or the goods displayed. The Exhibitor is responsible for the supervision of his stands, equipment and goods during setting up and dismantling phases as well as during the exhibition.

7.10. CONTRACT VALIDITY

The Organizer, represented by the CEO, or any other person designated by him as a supervisor, has the right - at any time during the working hours - to carry out controls in compliance with the spaces assigned and to verify the respect of obligations arising from this contract. The Exhibitor must sign and send the "Business Terms & Conditions 2019" together with the annexes required for the specific case:

- "Exhibitor Personal Data 2019" form duly filled and signed
- If the Exhibitor hires external companies for setting up his stand: ANNEX A Correct execution of electric installation and equipment, ANNEX B Conformity of electrical system in case of electrical system installation, ANNEX C Correct installation.
- In case a specific construction of space is required: ANNEX E Stand layout

The Organizer has the right to unilaterally terminate the contract in case of breach of the obligations, unless the applicant is entitled to be indemnified under any circumstances. In case the Exhibitor does not respect all the articles contained in the "Business Terms & Conditions 2019", the Organizer is not responsible for any legal, economic and / or visual consequences and the Organizer can seek for compensation against the Exhibitor. Moreover, the Organizer has the right to remove those guilty from the event and / or from the stand, without recognizing to the removed Exhibitor the reimbursement of the sums due for the rental of space and services. The Organizer can integrate and cancel the previous provisions, and / or modify them. In this case, the Organizer must inform the Exhibitor.

7.11. WITHDRAWAL

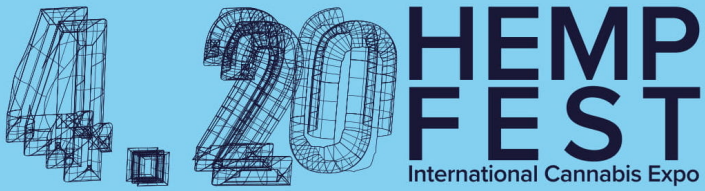
In case of withdrawal, justified and communicated in writing by April, 1st 2019 the Organizer will return the amount collected by deducting 50% of the amount due, as a forfeit. In case of withdrawal in the 30 days before the event the total amount due for space rental and other amounts relating to additional services requested and accepted, including sponsorship services, will be charged to the Exhibitor.

7.12. POSTPONEMENT AND INTERRUPTION OF THE EVENT

The Organizer has the exclusive right to change the dates, postpone the event, reduce or cancel it without the obligation to recognise a reimbursement to the Exhibitor. The Organizer is committed to send promptly information in case force majeure events occur until the opening day of the event.

7.13. EXCEPTIONAL EVENTS

Due to force majeure events or to any other exceptional event independent from the willingness of the Organizer, dates of the Fair can be changed, i.e. the event can be cancelled without involving any legal responsibility of the Organizer. In this case, the Organizer, after discharging commitments toward third parties and re-paying costs of organization already incurred for services already provided, will share among the Exhibitors residual obligations, proportionally to the undersigned amount of the square meters, in the limits of the payment already made by the Exhibitor. Eventual residual amounts will be shared among the participating Exhibitors. Installation and special installation expenses requested by the Exhibitor will be entirely refunded by the Exhibitor. The Exhibitor turns down asking for compensation for eventual damages by legal or extrajudicial means.



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7.14. DISPUTES

In case of disputes the jurisdiction is exclusively the court of Rome. This text has been written both in Italian and English, but only the Italian version is deemed authentic.

This general regulation is to be considered an integral part of the stand and "Services Lease Contract".
